#### INTRODUCTION

In addition, Enterprise Europe NI is hosted by Invest Northern Ireland. The network can provide direct contact with market research centres throughout Europe and is a first point of contact for researching European Dairy markets.

#### What our research reports say about the dairy market:

**Trends**: a high level of dairy products that have been launched between 2007 and 2012 are low-fat, catering to those concerned about high levels of fat in dairy products. Smaller portions are also more popular amongst the health conscious. However, there is room in the market for hybrid products that combine ice cream and confectionery. Local sourcing is increasingly important to Irish consumers. (source: Keynote).

**Yoghurt** - Ireland has the 2<sup>nd</sup> highest per capita consumption in Europe (34kg per capita – Sweden consumes 39 kg – Source: Business Monitor). This is currently being bolstered by its use in cooking. (Source: Mintel).

**Flavoured milk** - opportunities exist to attract new customer segments, such as young women and older consumers, to this increasingly popular product segment. (Source: Mintel).

The **global** milk and dairy market is buzzing from the growing demand for products in emerging and newly industrialised states. (source: Keynote).
