In early 2020 Sensée, a company with a pioneering approach to working from home, announced its intention to create 300 jobs in Northern Ireland with support from Invest NI.

Sensée provides home-based contact centre agents on an outsourced basis. Its agents deal with inbound calls from clients such as Allianz, Bupa, Hastings Direct, Legal & General and SSE either as an overflow resource to handle peaks in demand or as a complete service. Sensée focuses on ensuring the right people are recruited for the roles to ensure they can offer brilliant service to their customers.

The Sensée homeworking model removes barriers for various groups of people and gives them an opportunity of employment regardless of location. In fact, 18 per cent of employees are registered as disabled, 30 per cent are living in rural areas and, contrary to the sector generally, average employee age is 41.

Sensée is attractive to prospective employees. Its 700 strong team is employed on permanent contracts, with pensions, sickness and holiday pay. The company has developed technical solutions and processes to overcome the challenges that can face homeworkers. The firm ensures staff feel supported and outside of work organises a range of social activities including virtual movie nights and virtual Christmas parties.

Sensée visited Northern Ireland a number of times in early 2019 and quickly chose the region for this operation because of:-

- The quality and availability of talent in Northern Ireland
- The excellent network of key stakeholders in local government and communities
- The financial and non-financial support offered from Invest NI.
