

Mentoring



Accessing expertise through Mentoring can be an effective way to accelerate business growth, ensure success and lead to higher productivity and growth.

What is mentoring?

Mentoring is a relationship in which a person is supported through a learning or developmental journey. It's about reflecting, encouraging and supporting you as a business owner through consistent support, guidance and practical help.

What can a mentor do for you?

A mentor is someone who will encourage and support you to make the most of yourself and your business.

A business/enterprise mentor is normally someone who has a great deal of entrepreneurial business experience and who acts as a trusted confidante over a flexible period of time.

Although the final decisions are always in your hands, a mentor can be invaluable in guiding you to identify the support you need, consider your options and get new information.

As a mentor, their role is to be a trusted confidante, helping you to make informed choices.

Mentoring scheme

The Invest NI Mentoring scheme provides financial support to Invest NI customers to engage a Business Mentor who will work with the business to accelerate growth and to overcome specific barriers.

The Business Mentor will provide expertise, support and challenge. They will assist you to consider your options to make the right decisions for your company.

Support

Up to £4,000 or 49% of eligible costs, whichever is the lesser, over 12 months to engage with an experienced Business Mentor.

The company

Glowmetrics is a digital analytics agency based in Belfast. The company was established in 2012 and provides a digital analytics consultancy service to help companies manage their digital data better. They produce actionable insights that businesses can use to better power their digital properties and produce more effective and trackable marketing campaigns.

The challenge
