







WHAT IS DUAL MARKET ACCESS?

Northern Ireland is the only region in the world with Dual Market Access for goods to Great Britain (GB) and the European Union (EU).

That means businesses like yours can sell goods freely to both markets without restrictions such as customs checks, tariffs or regulatory barriers.







WHAT ARE

QUALIFYING NORTHERN IRELAND GOODS?

For unfettered access to Great Britain they must be:

"Qualifying Northern Ireland Goods".


This means the goods are in free circulation in Northern Ireland before they are moved from Northern Ireland to Great Britain (England, Scotland and Wales).


GB AND EU BUSINESSES TRADING WITH EACH OTHER?

Goods are traded between GB and the EU under either:

- World Trade Organisation Rules
- UK-EU Trade & Cooperation Agreement

This means:

- Customs declarations
- Regulatory checks
- Possible tariffs
- Possible origin certificates
- Costs!

Investment magnet: a prime location for businesses looking for a competitive edge.





EXPORTS TO THE EU






NI was the only UK region to grow manufacturing exports to the EU in 2023 and 2024.


