Most manufacturers already comply with much of the standard.

You're Already Most of the Way There



Manufacturers holding recognised food safety certifications, including BRCGS, FSSC 22000, IFS, and ISO 22000, typically already comply with around **80%** of the operational and management system requirements for Halal certification.



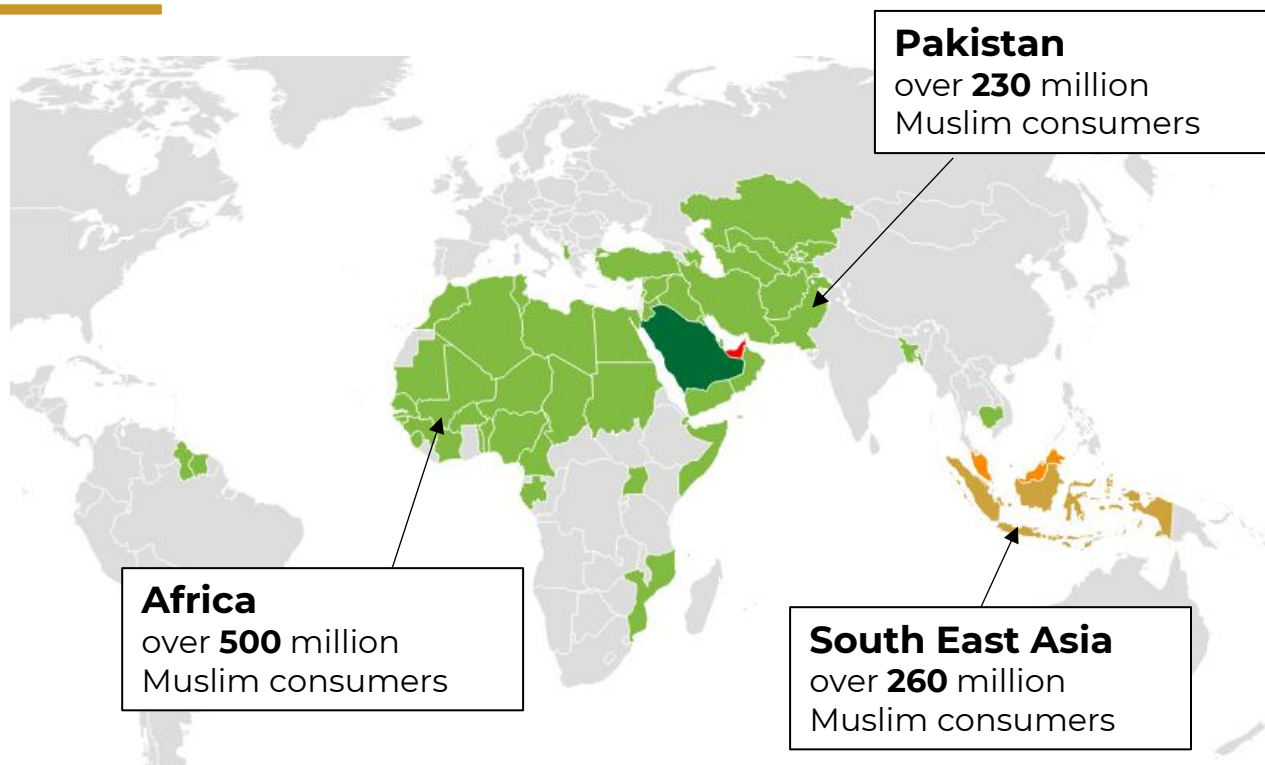
Only **specific Halal elements** usually need to be addressed.

Understanding Global Halal Standards

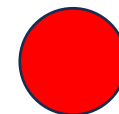


DHCE provides Halal certification services for all international markets. However, certification fees for Saudi Arabia, Singapore, Malaysia, Indonesia, and the UAE differ from our standard pricing due to additional regulatory and market-specific requirements.



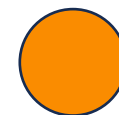
SAUDI ARABIA

SFDA Halal — Required for all Halal products exported to Saudi Arabia.



UNITED ARAB EMIRATES

UAE.S GSO 2055-1 — Mandatory for Halal certification in the UAE market.



MALAYSIA

MS 1500:2019 — Recognised globally. Strong reference standard.



SINGAPORE

MUIS Halal — Required for Halal products sold in Singapore.



INDONESIA

SNI 99001 — Mandatory for Halal products in Indonesia.



OIC / SMIIC

OIC/SMIIC 1:2019 — International standards for the Muslim world.

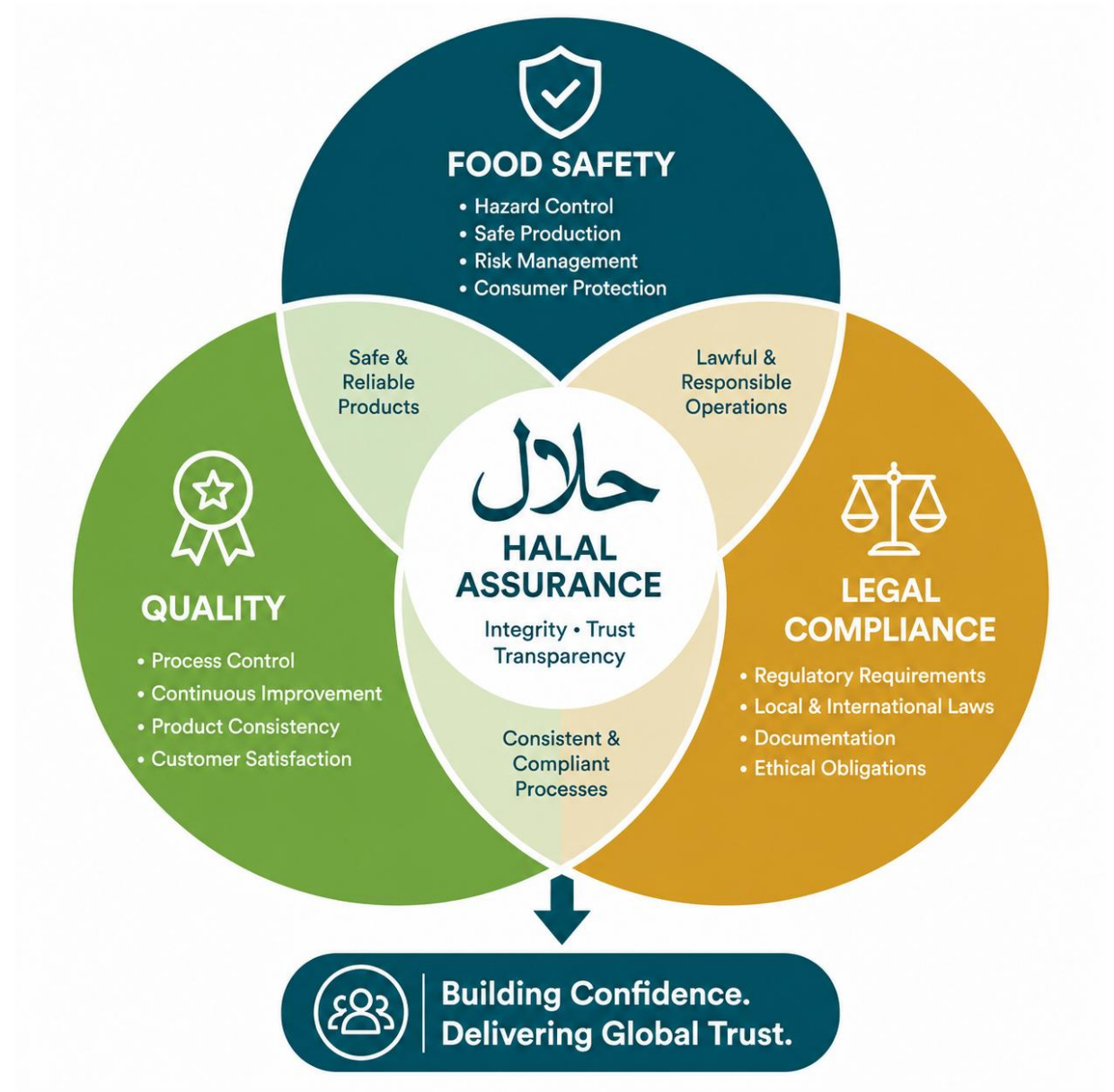

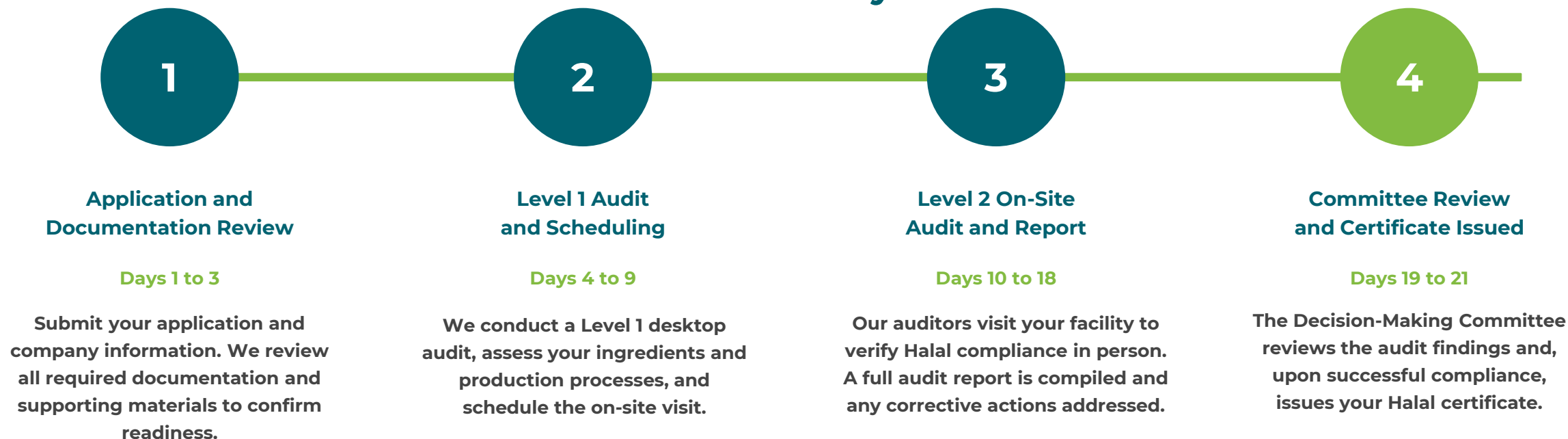
